The Associate of Science degree program in Business Management prepares graduates for management trainee positions in large businesses and for management positions in small companies and in non-profit organizations. Students receive a broad background in many of the business administration core competencies, so they are prepared for a variety of management positions.

Graduates of this degree program can also use their academic background as the first step in completion of a 4-year degree in any business administration major — Accounting, Finance, Management, Management Information Systems and Marketing. Most of these business administration majors are offered at University Center.

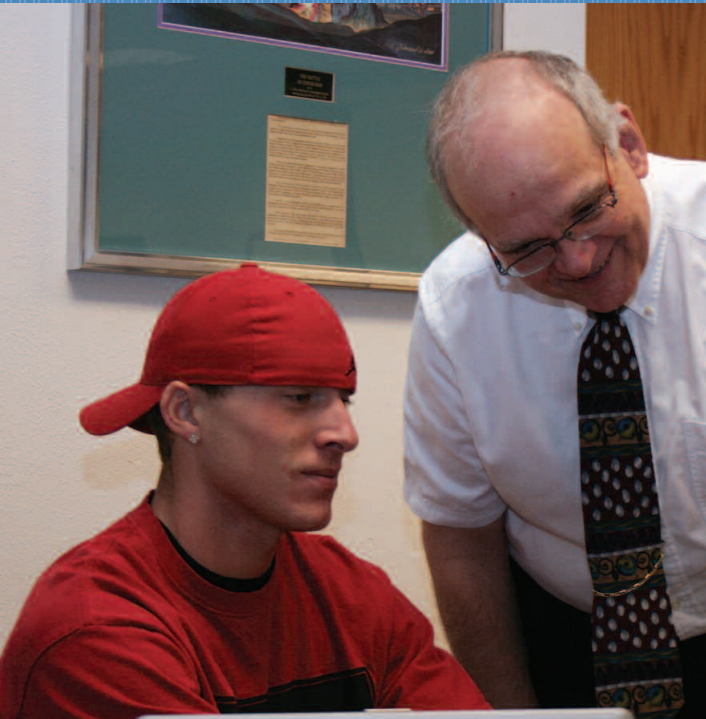
