Institutional Credit Requirement: Credit taken by students at DSU or at its approved sites using any approved method of delivery is considered institutional credit, including credit from courses that are part of a formal collaborative agreement between DSU and another regental university. The minimum number of credit hours that must be earned as institutional credit is 32 credits for the baccalaureate degree and 16 credits for the associate degree. The number of credit hours immediately preceding completion of the degree that must be earned as institutional credit is 16 of the last 32 credits for the baccalaureate degree and 8 of the last 16 for the associate degree. The minimum number of credit hours in the discipline of the major that must be completed as institutional credit is 50 percent.
